Bill—An additional Act for the regulation of

 read 1st & 2^d time & referred to the next Legislature.
 Sent up for concurrence.

Bill—An Act to incorporate the Ellsworth Bank
 was taken up—report of Conference read & accepted and
 then the House recede from their former vote and
 concur with the Senate & pass the Bill to be engrossed
 and the question was decided by Yeas & Nays as
 follows Yeas 74 Nays 57. [See appendix page 254.]

Bill—An Act to incorporate the Proprietors of Smiths
 { Stock in Bangor }
 came from the Senate that body insisting upon
 their vote passing the Bill to be engrossed—the House
 recede from their former vote and pass the Bill
 to be engrossed in concurrence.

Bill—An Act to authorize the cession of Jurisdiction,

 was read 1st 2^d & 3^d time & passed to be engrossed. Sent
