

Order from the House of Representatives, appointing Messrs. Emery of Sauc. Wells of Hallowell, Quimby of Westbrook, Newhall of Washington, Duck of Springfield, Richards of Ellsworth, McBellan of Eastport, Prescott of St. Albans, Thompson of Unity and Merritt of Jay, as a committee with such as the Senate may join, to inquire whether much expense may not be saved to this State by passing a general law, providing for the creation of private incorporations—read and passed and Messrs.
