A communication was received from A. G. Nichols, Secretary of the Board of Internal Improvements, submitting the First Report of Dr Charles J. Jackson on the Geology of Maine, and ordered on motion of M^{rs} Hamer, that the Secretary of State be directed to procure the printing of 5000 copies of said Report, on a plan similar to that of Professor Hitchcock of a like Survey of Massachusetts.

M^{rs} Mildram, from the Committee on Interior Waters to which was re-committed the Bill to incorporate the Hapsalborough and Sidney Darn Company reported that said Bill ought not to pass and said Report on motion of M^{rs} Scrabble, was laid upon the table.
