

Bill An Act creating the Village of Quinswick into a corporation for certain purposes, came again from the Senate with further amendments as on sheet D and the agreed thereto, and ordered the Bill to be engrossed as thus amended.

Petition of Edward Robinson & others of Sebec to be incorporated as a manufacturing Company was referred in concurrence with the Senate to the Committee on Manufactures.

Report on the order in relation to Broad Rimmed Wheels in the County of Washington & that legislation is inexpedient was accepted in concurrence with the Senate.

Bill An Act to provide for the sale & distribution of the ministerial and school lands in the Plantation No one County of Oxford, reported on the petitions of Thomas Richard & others, was read 1st & 2^d time and tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a 3^d reading.
