A message was received from the House of Representatives, that that Branch had reconsidered its vote passing to be engrossed the Bill entitled "an additional Act establishing Salaries for Judges and Registers of Probate" and had amended the title thereof, by striking out the words "an additional" and inserting the words "an Act additional to an" and passed the same to be re-engrossed as thus amended. The Senate reconsider their vote passing said Bill to be engrossed, adopt the amendment proposed by the House and order the same re-engrossed as thus amended, in concurrence.
