Passing along with Dr. Harlan one day he spoke with a young man and pretty soon he said that is a young man I turned off the other day for striking a patient.

Ques. You say the rule was, where a patient was injured by an attendant wrongfully, he should be discharged; did you ever know that rule to be violated. Ans. Not anything of that kind came to my knowledge.

Ques. During the whole 8 years, what was your observation as to the care of the attendants over the patients. Ans. That they were faithful, careful and affectionate as they could be, treated the patients kindly so far as we could ~~do~~ derive in going there.

Ques. You had access to all the wards at any time when you chose to go in. Ans. Yes, but it would not amount to anything
