Ordered That the joint standing committee on Literature and Literary Institutions be instructed to inquire into the expediency of revising all the Statutes relating to Schools - and also further inquire into the expediency of providing that a report of the condition of the Schools within this State accompanied by an abstract of the School returns be annually made to the Legislature. Sent up for concurrence.
