to call a meeting of said Proprietors.

The Subscribers proprietors of a tract
of Land lying in the late Province of Maine now
County of York holden under the Will of Bridget
Phillips late of Boston deceased, desire you would
call a meeting of the Proprietors of said Land as soon
as may be for the following purposes

To choose a Moderator

To choose a Clerk

To appoint an Agent to transact such Business as the
Proprietors shall judge expedient

To consider the Expediency of coming to a decision of
the Lands belonging to the Propriety and if they should
think proper to cause an actual division thereof either
in whole or in part as shall be thought best and
in case the Proprietors should not judge it necessary
to come to a division of said Land immediately to appoint
a Committee, or empower an Agent to make sale of such
Lands as shall be found to be taken up in such manner
and upon such terms as the said Committee or Agent
may judge most beneficial for the Propriety

To appoint a Committee to execute the Deeds to such
persons as may be agreed with by the Agent or
Committee of the Propriety

To empower a Committee or Agent in behalf of the
Proprietors to cause Writts of Trespass or Ejectment
to be brought against any person or persons who shall
appear to have trespassed on the Lands belonging
to the Proprietors or who have unlawfully entered on
the same in any part thereof

To consider what steps are proper to be taken re-
specting the Proprietors Land North of the Little
Oxapic and Great Oxapic Rivers
