

Sent down for concurrence. Concurred. 141.

Bill additional to an Act regulating Banks and Banking (laid upon the table by Mr. Burr) was read once and referred to the Committee on Banks and Banking. Sent down for concurrence. Concurred.

Resolue in favor of John Bartlett came up — the House insisting on its proposed amendment of the 30th of January. The Senate recommit said Resolue to the Committee on Military Pensions, with instructions to report a statement of facts. Sent down for concurrence, concurred.

Bill providing for the removal of the Seat of Government from Augusta to Portland came up — The House insisting on its vote passing the same to be engrossed, propose a conference, and appoint as conferees Messrs. Humphrey of Gray, Fiske of Bristol, Brooks of York, Allen of Bangor and Lowell of Cast Machias.

The Senate insists on their vote referring said Bill to the next Legislature — concur in the proposition for a conference, and appoint as conferees Messrs. Benson, Harris and Magoun.

Bill to repeal an Act requiring the use of Broad Rimmed Wheels in the County of Penobscot, so far as the same is appli-
-cable.
