

Resolve for the relief of Moses Saunders, Jun^r (laid 281.
upon the table by M^r Burke), was read and re-
ferred to the Committee on Military Pensions
Sent down for concurrence. Concurred.

Resolve relative to an amount of money
due to the State from Joel Miller, late War-
den of the State Prison was read the se-
cond time, and the same on motion of
M^r Suttlefield was laid upon the table.

Resolve in favor of Peol Fornas;
Bill to incorporate the Parkers Head Tide
Mill Company secondly read the second
time, amended and passed to be engrossed
as amended. Sent down for concurrence.
Concurred.

Bill additional to establish a Court of Com-
mon Pleas was taken up and passed to be
engrossed, in concurrence.

Bill providing for the distribution and re-
payment of the public money, apportioned
to the State of Maine, on deposit, by the gov-
ernment of the United States came up
from the House further amended, and
said Bill on motion of M^r Suttlefield was laid
on the table till to morrow ten o'clock.
