Resolve in favor of Patucktown plantation was read once and indefinitely postponed. Sent up for concurrence.

The Committees on Division of Towns - also on Claims - also on Military Pensions were severally discharged in concurrence from further services.

Bill An Act regulating Attachment on real estate was refused a passage agreeably to the report of the Committee, in concurrence with the Senate.
