Report on an Order relative to enlarging the powers of Judges of Probate, that legislation is expedient came from the Senate recommended for concurrence and the House concurred.

Resolve further providing for the promulgation of the Laws of the State, came from the Senate indefinitely postponed. The House nonconcurred and amended the Bill, and then passed the same to be engrossed as amended. Sent up for concurrence.

Resolve for the payment of Accounts against the State, was read a second time & passed to be engrossed. Sent up for concurrence.

Bill An additional Act to prevent gaming for money or other property, was read a third time & passed to be engrossed as amended. Sent up for concurrence.
