

Aug. 14. 1788 to consider what steps are proper to be taken  
respecting the Proprietors Lands both in the Little  
Osage and Great Osage Rivers. Voted that a  
Committee consisting of Samuel Adams Esq. Col. Joseph Waters, John  
Savery jun. & Mr. John Wheelwright, any two of whom  
to propose a Quoerum, be a Committee to settle the boundary  
line between the propriety and the Commonwealth and  
that the said Committee, if they should judge it expedient  
be authorized to confer and join with the Proprietors  
holding Lands under Samuel Phillips & William  
Phillips for the above purpose — also

Voted that Mr. Martin Krummer, Joseph Waters and John  
Wheelwright be a Committee to attend the Proprietors  
Land below at the Little Osage and Great Osage  
Rivers and that they be and are hereby authorized  
to take such steps as they may judge for the interest  
of this Propriety by making such appropriations or  
concessions of such parcel or tracts of Land lying  
between the said Rivers as others may appear  
necessary — The Proprietors hereby engaging to conjoin  
their efforts thereto  
Voted to adjourn to Monday the 16th of September next  
to meet at the Coffee House this Evening at 8 OClock P.M.  
and said meeting is accordingly adjourned
