Ordered that when the House adjourns, it
adjourn to meet at nine o'clock tomorrow morning.

Bill An Act prohibiting the emission & circulation
of Bank Bills of a small denomination and certain
others, was further amended — and then passed
to be engrossed — and the question was taken by
yeas & nays and decided as follows Yeas 93
Nays 73. [See appendix page 81]. Sent up for
concurrence.

And then the House adjourned.
