Q. Have you ever had crews of the patients and attendants working with you picking hair mattresses and matters of that sort? A. Yes, some times we have had a dozen, and I have had 30 or 40.

Q. Patients and attendants also? A. Yes, sir.

Q. And for some length of time? A. It would be 2 or 3 hours in the forenoon and about the same time in the afternoon.

Q. So you have had pretty good opportunities of judging? A. Yes sir.

By Dr. Butler:

Q. Whereabouts have you worked? A. About all parts; through the first and middle floors or halls, whatever you call them, I never worked much in the lower halls. I have worked in the upper and middle halls ^{mostly} used to cover patients through there.

Q. Were you ever there when a patient became violent? A. I don't know as I ever was. I have seen them take them some times and
