

Q. Didst you two to three hundred go 3 or 4 weeks without bathing?

A. I don't think there were as many as that. In the upper wards they washed in their rooms.

Q. How many of them didst get into a tub for 3 weeks?

A. I could not tell. There might have been 250.

Q. Suppose you had a fire over there and your patients were, not in the most dangerous places, but in their average places, could you get all your patients out do you think? A. I think we could very nearly. We have a good many avenues outside on each floor.

Q. Suppose a fire caught there and in 15 minutes the whole of one wing was on fire, could you get your patients all out? A. We could stop the fire. We have one of the best apparatus for stopping fire in the world. It is a stand-pipe in every stair-way with a reel of hose on every floor, and a stop cock which you open, and
