Resolve to amend the constitution in the fourth
 { section of the sixth article —
 was read a second time & referred to the next
 Legislature.

Bill An Act to incorporate the Nequamkeag Bank
 was read a third time & passed to be engrafted
 in concurrence.

Bill An Act for the further regulation of Banks
