Act to incorporate the Hennepin Port Granite and Rail Road Company (reported in the House, by same, on petition of the Directors of Hennepin Port, Granite and Rail Road Company;)

Bill to change the name of the Portland Thread Company (reported in House, by same, on petition of the Directors of the Portland Thread Company;)

to incorporate the Brunswick Savings Institution (reported by Mr. Magnus from the Committee on Banks and Banking, on petition of John McQueen and others;)

to prevent fraud in the sale and purchase of Hay (reported by Mr. Littlefield, from the Committee on the Judiciary, on an order relative to the purchase of hay;)

additional to an Act to incorporate the Emerson Sluice Company (reported by Mr. Mildram, from the Committee on Interior Waters, on petition of George Pierce and others;); severally read once and to morrow ten o'clock assigned for a second reading.
