Tuesday Feb 16th 1790 The Proprietors of common
and ungranted Land in the late Province of Maine

Adjournment at the house of Col. Josiah Waters -

Col. Waters acquainted the Proprietors with what he had
done in pursuance of a Vote of the Propriety at their
last meeting and that he had applied to an able
Lawyer upon the subject - Voted that Col. Josiah
Waters agent to the Propriety be and he is by is
empowered to agree with Theophilus Parsons Es
to support our claims to the Lands between Great
Springs and Little Springs Rivers in the best and
easiest manner he is able -

Voted to adjourn to Tuesday the 16th March next
to meet at the house of Col. Josiah Waters at 6 O'clock P.M.
and said meeting is accordingly adjourned
