

Resolve in favor of Henry L. Noyes (re-
 = ported by the Committee on Mil-
 = itary Pensions on petition of
 said Noyes

authorizing the Secretary of State
 to furnish the new towns with Green-
 leaf's Maps of Maine (introduced in
 the House, severally read once and
 to morrow ten o'clock assigned for a se-
 cond reading)

Bill providing for the repeal of an Act
 entitled an Act to establish a Mu-
 nicipal Court in the town of Hat-
 lowell was read the second time
 and the same on motions of Mr. Lit-
 tlefield, was laid upon the table.

Bill to authorize the town of Pittston
 to dispose of the old Meeting House

 House) came up from the House of
 Representatives. The Senate decided
 said Bill to be out of order and refused
 action on the same - a document
 of similar import, having been by a joint
 vote of the two Houses referred to the
 next Legislature.
