The Senate reconsider their vote passing said Bill to be engrossed, adopt the amendment proposed by the House and order said Bill reengrossed as thus amended in concurrence.

Resolve for the payment of Accounts against the State was read the second time. Mr. Greene moved to amend by striking out the figures, "45" in the 16th line, page 11, and inserting in lieu thereof 68 and altering the aggregate in the 31st line to agree therewith. And the question of thus amending was decided in the negative, as follows to wit:

Nays. Messrs. Ham, Manning, Mildram, Rogers, Severance, Smith, Soule, Staples, Swift, Whitney and Woodman ————— 11.

And said Resolve passed to be engrossed, in concurrence.
