

Perhaps so many did not work out last summer. Last summer they went into the park. Some days every patient who could walk was in the park. Last summer possibly 20 or an average worked on the farm. The others, for exercise, walked in the park and halls. The rule is for patients to bathe every week, often when necessary. Last summer every patient bathed every week except a short time when the water was low, from the last of Aug. into Oct. I think. There was one ward where they bathed every week and so many water was carried from the pipes. Don't think any of them went as long as 6 weeks without bathing. Perhaps some of them went 3 weeks without a bath, I don't remember exactly but can't tell how many went that length of time. The fact of the matter was we were short of water and that is all there is to it. In some halls they didn't bathe for 2 or 3 weeks
