Bill to prohibit Boom, Dam and Mill owners from stopping and detaining logs in certain cases, (reported by the Committee on Interior Waters, on an order relative to booms;)

- to incorporate the Baring and Bog Brook Railway Company, (reported by the Committee on Rail Roads and Canals, on petition of Joseph Granger and others;)
- in addition to an Act to incorporate the Neguemeag Mill Dam Company,
- to incorporate the Bushahegan Land and Mill Company, (reported by the Committee on Manufactures, on petition of Horace Baker (and others;))

Resolve in favor of Elizabeth Beckler and James Packard, (reported by the Committee on State Lands, on petition of said Beckler (and Packard),

- authorizing a loan of money, (reported by the Committee on Finance,) severally read once and three o'clock in the afternoon signed for a second reading.

Bill to incorporate the Kenduskeag Manufacturing Company,

- repealing an additional Act regulating the inspection of Beef and Pork, (reported by Mr. Littlefield on an order relative to that subject, (severally read once and seven o'clock this evening signed for a second reading.)
