There are two systems of ventilation in use, and ours is called the system of induction while theirs is the forced system. Ours has been carried about as far as a system of induction will go, with this exception: that the flues which conduct the air from the halls and the rooms are in many cases, smaller than would have been put in were the trustees building them then. But they existed in the walls and they made the best use of them they could. If any defect exists in them it was owing to the ancient construction of the building.

Dr. Butler: The system of induction is that - that is used at the Capitol at Washington is it? A. I believe they have some thing of that and some thing of the free system there. I should not wish to be responsible for any statement
