The Committee on engrossed Bills reported a study engrossed
 Resolve relating to the election of President & Vice President
 — Preamble & Resolutions instructing our Senators
 { and Representatives in Congress in relation
 to Fortifications — which
 — providing for Pockets for the use of the Legislature
 were severally finally passed. Sent up for concurrence

Resolve on the Pay Roll of the Senate was read

 the Senate may join be a Committee to inform the
 Governor that the two Houses have passed on all
 the business before them, & if he has nothing more
 to communicate, they are ready to adjourn without
 day.

 agreed thereto and the Clerk acquainted the
 Senate there with.
