Met according to adjournment

Resolve An additional Resolve for the benefit of the Blind, laid on the table by Mr Scammon of Williston was read once and tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a second reading.

On motion of Mr Walton of Portland

Ordered, That the Secretary of State cause to be published, in the several papers within the State, in which the Public Acts are promulgated, An Act passed March 2^d 1833 requiring the Inspectors of smoked and pickled Fish to make annual returns of their inspection to the office of the Secretary of State. Sent up for concurrence

On motion of Mr Holmes of Alfred

Ordered That the Secretary of State cause to be printed forthwith three hundred copies of an act entitled "an Act defining certain rights and duties of Railroad Corporations" passed at the present session, & distribute the same among the members of the Legislature. Sent up for concurrence.
