person producing credentials signed by the Selectmen
of towns and Deputies of Plantations as the case may
be, and attested by their respective town or plantation
Clerks shall be conclusive evidence that such Repre-
sentative is legally chosen, & no person shall be allowed
to hold a seat in this House as a Representative unless
he produce such credentials. Sent up for concurrence
