

The following is a Letter from the several
Proprietors to the Clerk requesting him to call a Meeting

Boston Novem^r. 16. 1732

Sir

We the subscribers Proprietors of a Tract
of Land lying in the late Province of Maine now County
of York holden under the Will of Bridget Phillips
late of Boston deceased, desire you would call on
meeting of the Proprietors of said Land as soon as may
be for the following Purposes. —

To choose a Moderator

To choose a Clerk

To choose an Agent, or Agents to prosecute, and defend
suits that may be commenced for, or against, said
Proprietors, and to regain the Possession of such Lands
as have been taken up, and possessed by Trespassers
and tortious Enters

To consider the Propriety of making, and executing
according to Law good, and sufficient Deed or
Deeds of release, and quit Claim according to the
true Intent, and meaning of the Act confirming
the Lands holden under William Phillips, and
Bridget Phillips late of Boston deceased passed
the Thirtieth of October last, and to the Acceptance
of the Committee appointed by the Honble General
Court mentioned in said Act

To choose a Committee to settle the boundary
Lines between the several Towns, and the Proprietors
of Lands contiguous to the Lands holden under
the said Bridget Phillips
