Mrs Sandford of Topsham & Chadbourne of Standish has leave of absence from & after Thursday next Mr Chadbourne of Limerick from and after today and Mr Cook of Waterboro' from and after Wednesday next.

Bill An Act to incorporate the Bucksport Stage and Hotel Company, was read a third time referred to the Committee on the Judiciary. Sent up for concurrence.

Leave to withdraw, was granted in concurrence on Petition of Benjamin Libby & others for a Park.

The Committee on the Incorporation of Towns, were discharged in concurrence from further service.

Report on the Order to inquire into the expediency of appointing a Committee to examine into the concerns of the State Prison, that legislation is inexpedient, was read & accepted in concurrence.

Bill An Act to set off a tract of land from Lawiston to Greene, came from the Senate, that body insisting upon their vote of the 22 inst indefinitely postponing the same. The House insist upon their vote passing the same to be engrossed, propose a conference and appoint as conferees, Messrs Allen of Greene Humphrey of Gray & Morritt of Jay. Sent up for concurrence.
