Honble Judge Sewall exhibited an Account of sundry  
Charges to the Proprietors claiming Lands under the  
Will of Bridget Phillips amounting to £48:11:1  
due for Services in the Years 1772-3 & 4 which was  
read & accepted and thereupon voted that Mr  
William Phillips Junr. Treasurer be and he hereby  
is directed to pay the Honble David Sewall Esq.  
what Money he has on Hand belonging to the  
said Propriety

voted that Col. Josiah Waters agent of said Propriety  
be and he hereby is empowered to employ a Surveyor  
or Surveyors as he shall think expedient, to survey  
the Lands of the Proprietors in the County of York  
any Vote to the contrary notwithstanding

Col. Waters reported to the Proprietors that he proceeded  
to Massachusetts agreeably to his Appointment of the  
26<sup>th</sup> of the Inst last and had before them the Orders  
he gave Mr. Bourley

voted to adjourn to Tuesday the 25. Inst next  
to meet at the Coffee House in Boston at 6 OClock  
P. M. and said meeting is accordingly adjourned
