

X. Monday 13th March 1706 The Proprietors of a certain Tract of Land lying in the late Province of New England under the Will of Bridget Phillips late of Boston deceased met according to the adjournment at the Coffee House in Boston
Present —

The Committee appointed to agree upon, settle and fix the Line between the Lands of the Propriety holders under Bridget Phillips in the late Province of Maine and any Land adjoining with the Proprietors claimin part of Bowhall in the County of York by deed from Harlakenden Symonds to Roger Haskins and thirty five others dated June 1688 & reported a deed executed and signed by Samuel Baker Sep^r 1706 and the Settlement of the dividing Line between the Proprietors, and Bridget Phillips and those under Haskins and others by their Agents —

The Proprietors took the same under Consideration and thereupon VOTED — That the proceedings of the Agent (Col^o Josiah Waters) be and hereby are approved, and ratified and that the deeds and Ratification be entered not only upon the Records of this Propriety; but recorded in the Registered Office in County of York —

To all People to whom these presents shall come the Proprietors of that part of Bowhall, so called in the County of York purchased by Roger Haskins and thirty five others of Harlakenden Symonds by his deed on record dated June 12. 1688 being a Tract of Land of Six miles long, and four miles wide lying at the head of Wells and Annsdale send Greeting —

Whereas the said Proprietors by deed indented and made the fourteenth day of September current between them and the Proprietors
