

Friday March 11th 1836

Met according to adjournment.

Petition of James S. Holmes & report thereon was referred in concurrence to the Committee on State Roads.

Report on petition of Josiah Parlin & others ordering Notice, was read & accepted in concurrence.

Report on petition of Solomon McKenney & others granting Leave to Withdraw - came from the Senate accepted for concurrence - The House nonconcurred & recommitted the same. Sent up for concurrence.

The Committee on the Division of Towns reported that they have disposed of all the business before them, and requested to be discharged - and the report was laid on the table.

Petition of George Stevens & others - came from the Senate referred to the next Legislature for concurrence, and the House concurred.

Bill An Act to incorporate the Howes Line Stage Company, was read a 3^d time & passed to be engrossed in concurrence.

Resolve in favor of the Belfast & Quebec Rail Road was read a second time and amended, and then passed to be engrossed by yeas 104 - yeas 97 yeas 65.
