On motion by Mr Sotter of Augusta

Ordered, That Messrs Sotter of Augusta, At-
 Antone of Sawensfield, Soule of Freeport, Rollins of
 Neshleboro, Neiges of Trenton, Lippincot of Columbia
 McMillan of Fryeburg, Cole of Mowson, Adams
 of Lincoln & Boardman of Islesboro with such as the
 Senate may join be instructed to inquire into the ex-
 pediency of so altering the law, relative to criminal pro-
 secutions, as that each County shall pay the costs arising
 in such prosecutions at the terms of the Judicial Courts
 held in such County. — Also that the respective
 Counties shall be entitled to receive and retain to their
 own use, all fines, forfeitures and costs accruing in
 criminal prosecutions within said Counties. Sent
 up for concurrence.
