

The committee on engrossed Bills reported as truly engrossed Bill An Act to incorporate the Maine Granite Company which was passed to be enacted. Sent up for concurrence.

Bill An Act establishing the salary of the Attorney General - was read a 3<sup>d</sup> time & passage refused - and the question was taken by yeas & nays & decided as follows yeas 37 nays 109. Sent up for concurrence. [See appendix page 96]

Resolve relating to the discussion of Slavery in Maine was read a 3<sup>d</sup> time and passed to be engrossed and the question was decided by yeas & nays as follows Yeas 153 Nays 11. [See appendix page 101]. Sent up for concurrence.

Bill An Act to incorporate the Hampden & Carmel Canal & Railroad Company was read a 3<sup>d</sup> time and passed to be engrossed. Sent up for concurrence.

Bill An Act concerning Stud horses and Jacks was read a 3<sup>d</sup> time and passed to be engrossed with an amendments. Sent up for concurrence.
