Bill to incorporate to incorporate the Gardiner Shoe Manufacturing Company, (reported by the Committee on Manufactures, on petition of Robert Thompson and others) was read once and three o'clock, in the afternoon assigned for a second reading)

Resolve for the appointment of Clerks to assist the Commissioners in revising the public laws of the State, (reported with an amendment by Mr. Littlefield from the Joint Select Committee to which said Resolve had been committed,)

Bill to incorporate Farewell's Island Side Boom Company, (reported by the Committee on Interior Waters, on petition of Samuel Homans and others,)

" additional to an act regulating Judicial process and proceedings, (introduced in the House) severally read once and tomorrow ten o'clock assigned for a second reading.

Bill additional respecting Sheriffs, (reported by the Committee on the Judiciary, to which said Bill had been referred,) read once and the amendments of the House adopted. Mr. Littlefield moved to postpone the same indefinitely — and the question was decided in the negative by yeas and nays as follows to wit.
