

All a meeting of the Proprietors by Adjournment  
at the Common Head on Wednesday June 14<sup>th</sup> 1769  
Voted that Nathl Sparhawk be & hereby is desired to receive  
the Blount's conveyance & state the just proportion of the  
several rights of the Proprietors to the land belonging to the  
Proprietors: and that he be empowered to employ such persons or  
persons as he shall judge most capable of advising him in this  
business

Voted that Nathl Sparhawk be & hereby is empowered  
fully, to take advice of any person or persons learned in  
the Law: & upon such advice, in behalf of the Proprietors to  
bring writ of Emptio & Quiliment against any person or  
persons, who have trespass or may trespass trespass on  
lands belonging to the Proprietors: or who have unlawfully  
entered or may hereafter unlawfully enter in the same  
or any part thereof

Voted that Nathl Sparhawk be & hereby is desired to get the  
Plan of the Land belonging to the Proprietors completed  
open or may be  
Then the meeting was adjourned to Wednesday the  
Eighth Day of November next ensuing.  
The meeting of the Proprietors by Adjournment  
at Common Head in Boston Nov 8<sup>th</sup> 1769  
Nathl Sparhawk being the Moderator being absent  
Voted that Thomas Purching be & Moderator pro  
tempore

Then the meeting was adjourned to Thursday the  
15<sup>th</sup> Instant, to meet in their place at 6 o'clock P.M.  
The Meeting of the Proprietors by Adjournment at the Common  
Head on Thursday the 16<sup>th</sup> Nov 1769  
Voted that this Meeting be adjourned till tomorrow at twelve  
o'clock then to be held at their place - and it was accordingly  
adjourned
