

County Roads over certain public land was taken up, and the same, on motion of Mr. Benson was referred to the next Legislature. Sent down for concurrence. Concurred.

Bill to prevent obstruction to the navigation in Union River was read the second time (and passed to be engrossed, in concurrence).

Bill to secure to Mechanics (and others) payment for their labor and materials expended in erecting and repairing houses (and other buildings), with their appurtenances, — providing for the organization of plantations severally came up from the House amended. The Senate recede from their vote passing the said Bills to be engrossed, adopt the amendments proposed by the House (and pass said Bills to be engrossed as amended, in concurrence).

Bill to change the names of certain persons — additional for the preservation of Salmon, Shad (and) Alewives in Penobscot river and Bay and their tributary waters — severally read the second time, the amendments of the House adopted, and said Bills passed to be engrossed as amended, in concurrence.

The Joint Select Committee to which were recommitted the Report (and) Resolves relatives relative to the North Eastern Boundary, reported said Report with amendments,
