

Bill An Act to incorporate the Buckshot Mill and water power company, was read twice & referred to the next Legislature. Sent up for concurrence.

Report on an order relative to an Engine for the Public Buildings - and on an order relative to warming the State House with hot air, that the committee on those subjects be discharged was read & accepted in concurrence.

The committee on Banks & Banking were discharged from any further service in concurrence.

Report on the petition of Timothy F. Hanson & others - granting leave to withdraw, was read & accepted. Sent up for concurrence.

Resolves relating to the election of President and Vice President, came from the Senate with the report thereon accepted and the Resolves passed to be engrossed - The House amended the Report of the Committee and passed the Resolves marked 58. to be engrossed. Sent up for concurrence. The question on amending said Report was decided by yeas and nays as follows yeas 59 nays 37. [See appendix page 258.]
