The subscribers, proprietors of a Tract of
Land lying in the late Province of Maine now
County of York holden under the Will of Bridget
Phillips late of Boston deceased desire you would
call a meeting of the proprietors of said Land as soon
as may be for the following purposes. —

To choose a Committee to execute a deed, ~~or deeds~~
ordered to persons agreed with, in behalf of the
proprietors —

To make provision for the payment of such
accounts as shall be exhibited to the proprietors.

To satisfy, and confirm the doings of their Agents
where the same is not already done, and as may
appear to be right —

To agree upon a Mode for the division of the Land
so that what is not already sold or particularly
appropriated may be immediately divided —

To consider what steps may be proper to be taken
respecting the proprietors Lands North of Little
Springs and Great Springs Rivers and to transact
any other Matters that may appear necessary and
advantageous —
