about 30. Joe told the above tale of haicd & bread ^{& further} ^{who is in the book of the tent with Joe Sam, said Joe Sam was married with his father's English} Mary Ann Saukees married Paul Leusta and died at Algonquin Island. ^{She was father's nurse when a child - Natagis}
