Voted that the Rev. Doct. Lathrop be Moderator of the  
meeting P. Jamis

The last Paragraph in the Committees report which was  
assigned for consideration at this meeting - Voted that  
it be referred to another opportunity

Voted - That Col. Josiah Waters who was appointed Agent  
at the last meeting for certain purposes be and he  
hereby is empowered to prosecute, and defend suits  
that may be commenced for, or against <sup>said</sup> Proprietors  
and to regain the Possession of such Lands as have  
been taken up, and possessed by Trespassers, and  
other interests and to commence, and prosecute all  
such actions as he shall judge necessary for the  
above purposes -

Voted That the Sum of £12 £00 be raised, and laid  
upon the several rights belonging to the Proprietors  
claiming Lands under the Will of Bridget Phillips  
in the County of York for the purpose of carrying on  
Prosecutions against certain persons mentioned in  
the report of the Committee Feb<sup>ry</sup> 27<sup>th</sup> last and said Sum  
when raised to be paid to Col. Josiah Waters (Agent)  
to be accountable for the expensiture of the same  
and that the Clerk be desired to proportion the Sum  
aforesaid among the Proprietors according to their  
respective Interest in the said Lands
