

Bill—An Act additional to an Act to organize, govern & discipline the Militia of this State, was read a 3^d time and amended & then recommitted with instructions to Report tomorrow. Sent up for concurrence.

Governors Message, [see appendix page 18.] transmitting address & Resolutions of Alabama on the subject of Slavery, was read & referred to the Committee who have under consideration the South Carolina Resolutions, in concurrence.

Petition of A. H. Rice & others for a Bank at Foxcroft was read & referred in concurrence to the Committee on Banks & Banking.

Remonstrance of David Dunlap & others against the petition of Moses Mason Sr., was referred in concurrence to the Committee on Rail Roads & Canals.

Bill—An Act to incorporate the Kennebec & Boston Steam Navigation Company, was read a third time the amendment proposed by the Senate, nonconcurring, and the Bill passed to be engrossed as amended by the House on sheet annexed marked K. Sent up for concurrence.

Bill—An Act to incorporate the Proprietors of the Warren Bridge was read a 1st & 2^d time & tomorrow at 10 o'clock assigned for a 3^d reading.
