Ordered, That Ephraim Weeks now holding a seat in this House from the town of Jefferson in the county of Lincoln is not entitled to the same.

Ordered, That Jesse Rowell claiming the right to hold a seat in this House from said town of Jefferson is constitutionally entitled to the same. Read and passed — and the question of passing the same was taken by yeas and nays and decided in the affirmative as follows Yeas 105 Nays 43. [See appendix page 32.]
