

Monday March 28th 1836

Met according to adjournment.

On motion of Mr Foster of Pembroke

Ordered, That the House of Representatives hold a session every evening till the recess commencing at seven o'clock.

Resolve for the relief of Solomon Littlefield, was read a second time & passed to be engrossed with an amendment. Sent up for concurrence.

Bill Ans Act in addition to an Act for the preservation of Salmon, Shad and Mewives in the Penobscot River and Bay and their tributary waters, came from the Senate amended for concurrence - the House agreed thereto & passed the bill to be engrossed in concurrence with the Senate.
