

Leut. Gov. John Aittean -

Aittean was ~~Leut.~~ - governor at the time when the office was held for life. After Neptunio's death he became governor. He was the father of Joe Aittean; lived at Matty nasook. He was not the "blue-eyed Indian" as depicted says - ~~that was a man~~ - do not know.

He was a large man of fine figure & always wore a long broad cloth cloak with a collar of deep red made of the shaggy end of broad cloth.

Joe Aittean, the son, Threenu's guide was drowned in Grand Falls, Nut Branch (near Forster's) July 4. 1870

St. Gov. John's tombstone says he was the son of Aittean, that is quite a chief place called "Aittean" of Neptunio.
