

Monday, February 27th 1837 277

Order from the House of Representatives, directing the Committee on the Judiciary to inquire into the expediency of providing by law that one tenant in common may maintain an action of trespass quare clausum fregit against his cotenant who hinders him from entering and occupying read and passed, in concurrence.

Petition of Samuel Wheeler and others, praying for the repeal of the license laws read and referred to the Committee that have that subject under consideration, in concurrence.

Remonstrance of Levi Butler and others, against the petitions of Wendell Smith and others, relating to Engine and Firemen doing military duty read and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary that have under consideration said petitions, in concurrence.

Petition of Abner Taylor and others, praying for an Act to encourage the study of Anatomy, Surgery and Pathology read and referred to the Committee that have under consideration the petitions of D. H. Minick and others, in concurrence.
