Mr. Benson, from the Conference on the disagreeing vote of the two Houses of the Legislature, on the "Resolve authorizing the appointment of Clerks to assist the Commissioners in revising the public laws of the State", reported that the Conference of the two Branches had agreed upon an amendment to said Resolve — read and accepted.

And said Resolve passed to be engrossed with the amendment, recommended by the Conference, marked B.

Sent down for concurrence.

Resolves authorizing the distribution of the first Report of the Geology of the State came up — the House, having insisted on its vote passing the same to be engrossed with the amendments B and C, proposed a Conference, and appoint as Conference, Messrs. Holmes of Alfred, Allen of Bangor, and Lyman of Portland.

The Senate, insisting on the vote passing the said Resolves to be engrossed with the amendment C, concur in the proposition for a Conference and appoint as Conference, Messrs. Ham, Manning and Severance.
