So far as my observation has been, so far as I could learn from various sources, as a rule I have felt that the attendants intended to be very kind and indulgent to the patients, and exercised care of over them in treating them well and kindly.

Q. Was it been your observation that as a rule they do exercise that care?

A. Yes sir.

Q. And give that attention to the patients?

A. That is my opinion at any rate.
