Bill An Act repealing An Act entitled An
Act to prevent frauds in the inspection of Fish
was read a 3^d time. Sent up for concurrence.

Resolve in favor of certain Officers & Soldiers of the
Revolutionary war and the Widows of the deceased
Officers & Soldiers, was read twice & passed to be en-
grossed in concurrence.

Bill An Act requiring incorporated Companies
to contribute to the revenue of the State, was recom-
mended to the Committee on Finance.
