six per cent on Bills of Exchange, drafts, notes or any kind of paper whatever, payable in this State, or in any of the New England States, discounted or negotiated at any Bank in this State. — Also to prohibit Banks in this State from taking any new note, draft, bill of exchange, or any other kind of paper, in exchange for that which may be due or becoming due, unless dated on the day the original is due — Also to prohibit Banks in this State from taking ^{any interest} on any kind of paper discounted or negotiated, unless the interest, ~~the~~ ~~interest~~ so taken is reconed from the day the Bank pays out its money for such discount — Also to prohibit Banks in this State from receiving pay at their counter by renewal or otherwise, for any note, draft, bill of exchange or any other kind of paper, payable out of the place where the Bank is located, which takes or negotiates such paper — Also to prohibit Banks in this State from issuing in any shape whatever, the obligation of their Cashiers or any of their Officers payable at a future time — and the same, on motion of Mr. Littlefield, was laid upon the table.
